News from National/Regional – Chapter Congress was held on 11/1-3 in Dallas. Jeff and Darcy in attendance. The National finances are at a major loss heavily due to the Roundel. Likely the Roundel will be discontinued in a couple of years. As a result of the financial challenges, dues will increase by \$10 and the rebate will be reduced from \$13.30 per member per year to \$8.00 per member per year.
