## BMW M3 GT4 Celebrates 24-hour Premiere at Nürburgring

*Munich, 8th April 2009.*

**T**he BMW works drivers Augusto Farfus (BR), Jörg Müller (DE) and Andy Priaulx (GB) will line up at the 24-hour race on the Nürburgring's Nordschleife on 23rd/24th May 2009. This will also mark the debut of the BMW M3 GT4 at this legendary endurance race.

Müller and Priaulx will be behind the wheel of the BMW M3 GT4 when they race for Schubert Motorsport in the Eifel region. The two drivers, who are normally involved in a battle for glory for BMW in the FIA World Touring Car Championship (WTCC), will join forces with motor racing journalists Marcus Schurig (DE) and Jochen Übler (DE). The editors of the specialist "sport auto" magazine in Germany have many years of racing experience behind them, and have entered the "Green Hell" numerous times in the past. Together with tyre partner Dunlop, this quartet of drivers has its sights set on a top position in the SP10 class.

BMW Motorsport Director, Mario Theissen, says: "Although we will not be represented by a works team at this year's 24-hour race, our Customer Racing programme ensures that our fans will still see plenty of BMW racing cars and BMW works drivers. We will be particularly interested in how the new BMW M3 GT4 performs, which is fielded by Schubert Motorsport in cooperation with 'sport auto'. Jörg Müller and Andy Priaulx are two former overall winners in the Eifel. Spectators can certainly look forward to an exciting weekend."

The BMW M3 GT4, the youngest addition to the Customer Racing product range offered by the BMW Motorsport Distribution division, made its debut on the legendary Nordschleife in front of many BMW fans at last weekend's 56th ADAC Westfalenfahrt. After four hours, Müller and Übler were victorious in the SP10 class, and finished 30th overall.

The Nordschleife at the Nürburgring has played a very special role in the history of BMW. BMW drivers have enjoyed countless successes there since the first 24-hour race was held in 1970. Last year alone, one third of the 150 cars that completed the 24-hour race were BMW made. With 114 class victories, BMW is by far the most successful manufacturer in the history of the event.

To date, the marque has 18 overall victories to its name, and has even achieved a one-two on eight occasions. Most recently, the BMW M3 GTR enjoyed double success in 2004 and 2005. Jörg Müller was a member of the winning team back in 2004, while Priaulx was triumphant in 2005.

### Event Registration

This year all event registration will again be handled through [www.motorsportreg.com](http://www.motorsportreg.com).

Between now and when registration opens you need to do one of two things. If you don't already have an account at [motorsportreg.com](http://motorsportreg.com) you will need to create one. If you already have an account all you need to do is add the Badger Bimmers as one of your club memberships.

Motorsportreg.com does offer credit card payment services but at the present time we still will only allow payment by check. At the end of the registration process for an event a confirmation page will be displayed that contains information about where your check must be sent along with some waiver information. You must print the confirmation page, sign and date it and then send it in along with your check.

10. You are now ready to register for Badger Bimmers. Just return to the site, log-in using your identifier and password. The three Blackhawk Farms events will be available for registration. The Road America event will be available for registration later in the year.

ers may purchase the two-year Maintenance Program extension from an authorized BMW Center during the first four years after the vehicle's in-service date or 50,000 total miles, whichever comes first. MSRP for the extension ranges from \$1,395 to \$2,995, depending on the model. For a small surcharge, the period to enroll a vehicle is extended through the fifth year of vehicle age or 60,000 total miles. Most recently BMW made the M3, M5, M6, and Advanced Diesel models eligible for Maintenance Program extensions.

Purchasing a Maintenance Program Upgrade is simple: a BMW owner visits an Authorized BMW Center to enroll any BMW during the first five years or 60,000 miles of its service life. Starting in April, BMW shoppers can also visit BMWUSA.com and utilize the Build-Your-Own module to include the Maintenance Program extension as a vehicle accessory; once completed they can either send this information directly to a BMW Center or print it for their convenience. Once enrolled by the center, Maintenance Program coverage is extended on the vehicle through the sixth year of service or 100,000 total vehicle miles, whichever comes first. Maintenance Program coverage stays with the vehicle (rather than the buyer), so a BMW's second or even third owner may benefit from the coverage.

# BMW Team Wins 2nd Podium at Long Beach

Long Beach, CA – April 18, 2009

With a third-place GT2 class finish by the No. 92 M3 of Tommy Milner and Dirk Müller in the Tequila Patron American Le Mans Series at Long Beach, the BMW Rahal/Lettermann Racing Team reached the ALMS podium for the second consecutive race. The duo completed 70 laps around the 1.968-mile temporary street circuit in the one-hour-and-forty-minute contest. Bill Auberlen and Joey Hand scored their first points of the season, finishing eighth in the No. 90 M3 after losing four laps following a collision with a lapped competitor just past the one-hour mark.

Today's finish moves BMW to fourth in GT2 Manufacturer points. Milner and Müller now stand fifth in GT2 Driver points.

## PITTSBURGH VINTAGE GRAND PRIX TO HONOR BMW AS MARQUE IN 2009

*For Immediate Release*

**December 22, 2008 Pittsburgh, PA** --- The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix will honor BMW as its official Marque of the Year for their 2009 event. This 10-day automotive celebration, from July 10-19, will present two race weekends, five distinct car shows, a driving tour, a track day and a gala dinner ...all with the BMW as the star car.

BMW will be honored as the Marque of the Year during the 10-day festival from July 10-19, 2009.*

There is already a buzz circulating among the BMW community. If you are a BMW enthusiast, this will be a "must attend" event in 2009. The BMW Car Club of America (BMW CCA) in cooperation with the local Pittsburgh BMW Dealers Association are working on bringing some very special cars to Pittsburgh along with guest speakers, racers, and several hundred display cars. The goal is 300 BMWs for the display area and many others to race at BeaveRun and in a special BMW race in Schenley Park.

### **BMW Car Club of America**

Brett Sutton and Eric Zagrocki of the Allegheny Chapter of the BMW CCA are co-chairing Marque of the Year activities for the Grand Prix. They have been working to organize a great week of events. Brett Sutton, president stated "The BMW CCA has over 70,000 members across the county with 65 local chapters. The national office has strongly supported our efforts in organizing this event. This will be a regional event on the national calendar which will help with sponsorship opportunities and in drawing unique cars to Pittsburgh. In addition to our local chapter, our show at the PVGP has been supported by a long list of surrounding BMW clubs including among others, the Buckeye, Northern Ohio, Mountaineer, National Capital, Nittany, Peachtree and Genesee Valley Chapters.

Eric Zagrocki commented: "The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix is one of the most prestigious automotive events in the country. No other vintage race in the country compares to the Schenley Park weekend...curbs, stone walls and hay bales and the car shows are incredible. If you have an automotive interest, you will find something to like at the PVGP.... We are searching out some truly special cars. This should include vintage machinery that ran in Europe prior to the World War II as well as some unique modern cars that are rarely seen."

Sutton and Zagrocki emphasize that you do not need own a rare one-off car to participate in any of the Marque of the Year activities or any other Allegheny Chapter events. They expect that the club will have a huge gathering of the cars everyone knows best, and whether you drive a classic 2002 or a new X6 SUV, you will be welcome and find someone else that shares your interest.

When BMW was last honored at the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix back in 1998, the Marque tent showcased a fabulous display of the company's motorsports history and contained a collection of rare race and show cars which included the BMW/McClaren, less than three weeks from its win at LeMans. Sutton and Zagrocki plan once again to feature such special displays.

### Activities for BMW Enthusiasts

There are many opportunities for BMW owners to get involved. The July 10-12 weekend at BeaveRun in Wampum, PA includes a BMW CCA club race for all years, a chapter picnic and a High-Performance Driving School. During the week there are four special car shows. Monday July 13 is a special display of BMWs at the Walnut Street Car Show in Shadyside followed by the Tuesday July 14 Waterfront Car Cruise in Homestead. Wednesday July 15 is a jam-packed day for BMW owners as they parade through downtown Pittsburgh in the morning and settle into car displays at plazas amid the skyscrapers for the afternoon. That evening a PVGP Tune-Up Party is hosted at the Bossa Nova nightclub and includes a display of race cars and concours quality cars right on 7th Avenue. Furthermore there will be a spirited driving tour of the Laurel Highlands on

Friday July 17 featuring lunch and a tour of Falling Water.

The Schenley Park weekend is the only vintage race in the country which is run on city streets. The course includes curbs, stone walls, and lots of hay bales. In addition to racing, there are 2,000 show cars spread throughout the fairways of the Bob O'Connor Golf Course. Below the clubhouse you will find the Marque of the Year compound where 300 BMW car owners and guests will enjoy a variety of activities including a parade lap of the track on Sunday during the opening ceremonies.

### Charity

Most importantly, proceeds from the event benefit two very worthy charities, the Autism Society of Pittsburgh and Allegheny Valley School. The event is free to the public so proceeds are raised through sponsorship, concessions and donations from the 200,000 weekend spectators. A record \$171,000 was raised last year, bringing the 26 year total to an astounding \$2.4 million!
