Mustafa Downshifts...



Seems that every other article I write is about buying a car or something for the car. This happens to be one of those articles. As Milwaukee dragged its feet into spring, I knew that sooner or later I needed to get some summer rubber on the 5er. Normally I swap summer tires on around the end of March.

I know this because I always tried to have summer tires on before Gateway Tech in St. Louis, back when Gateway Tech was in St Louis at the end of March.

Not this year. Well into April, I was still running Pirelli Winter Sports and really feeling bad about wasting away valuable soft winter compound each time I drove the car. The weather helped a lot with my procrastination: I kept thinking there was going to be a snow storm at the end of April even though the Audi had its summer wheels starting mid April. Needless to say, I was able to justify my obvious double standard by suggesting that the quattro was much better equipped to handle a surprise than my 5er was.

Since I used the factory 17 inch rims the car came with for snow tires, the plan was to get a second set of wheels this spring and go on with life. After days of comparison shopping and economic analysis, I settled on a staggered setup with 18 inch Beyern wheels. These are made by TSW, and do not require centering rings like most other wheels. You should know that I have used centering rings on the Audi for the last five years without any problems whatsoever, so I am not really sure why I became overly concerned about this particular feature. Regardless, I settled on the Beyern mesh style for its looks, size, lack of centering rings, and its price.

So far so good, and I've only wasted 10 days on research. Of course now comes the hard part of selecting tires. The task is complicated by the staggered set up and comparisons were not as easy as they seemed. Certainly not if you over analyzed everything. I looked at various combinations of wheel and tire prices, mounting, shipping, costs all over the world wide interwebs. You could get the cheapest tires from one seller but couldn't get the Beyern wheels from them. The guys who had the wheels offered free mounting but gave you only three brands of tires to choose from. They also charged a lot for shipping. The lowest unit price for the tires and wheels came from different sellers, but when you combined the mounting and shipping, you erased the savings. Another 6 days gone. I built a spreadsheet model and optimized for price and nailed a seller with the lowest overall cost. Picked up the phone (because

I wanted to speak to a person just to be sure) and placed my order and was told everything was in stock and would be delivered by April 29. Great.

On April 26, still not having received the confirmation email, I called the seller to inquire about my order and was told that the wheels were back ordered and were expected to be delivered to them in two weeks, two and a half tops. Seriously. I remained calm. It turned out that my extra effort to speak with a human just to be sure was not necessarily a fool proof plan. So cancelled the order. As an interesting side note, I found it strange that the cancellation of a \$2k order did not even elicit an attempt by the sales guy to retain the sale. They could have easily tried to sell me something else rather than giving me my money back and saying "oh well, I guess that sale was not meant to be!" I think some training for the sales force is in order at that shop.

That same afternoon, after having revised and re-run my price-value model, I called another seller and placed an order that had free shipping, free mounting and a \$50 unadvertised rebate. I was able to upgrade to better rubber and still come considerably lower than the first time. The tires shipped the same day, arrived two days later, and were on the car on April 30. At the end, the best decision was the one made during a phone call, and with the help of a sales guy who knew what he was doing. He saved me money, I got what I wanted, and they got the sale.

Overanalyzing is in my nature. I cannot not build a spreadsheet and throw a couple of graphs at any problem that I can turn into a numbers game. On the other hand, you can't control everything and, at one point, you just have to make a decision.

I'm set until the inside of the rears wear out and I have to build a spreadsheet to figure if it makes sense to replace all four or just the two worn ones.

BMW RAHAL/LETTERMAN RACING TEAM

Utah Grand Prix Race Summary

Tooele, Utah – May 17, 2009

The BMW Rahal Letterman Racing Team soldiered to seventh and eighth place finishes in today's American Le Mans Series Utah Grand Prix. Despite strong qualifying results, prospects for the race outcome were altered at the start.

When the green flag flew, a series of car-to-car contacts throughout the field culminated in an incident between the two BMW M3s in Turn One. As a consequence of the collision, teammates Tommy Milner and Bill Auberlen were forced



to the pits for extensive repairs in the opening minutes of the race. Each M3 re-entered the race more than five laps down from the GT2 leader.

The balance of the race was without incident as Milner pit-

Motorsportreg.com does offer credit card payment services but at the present time we still will only allow payment by check. At the end of the registration process for an event a confirmation page will be displayed that contains information about where your check must be sent along with some waiver information. You must print the confirmation page, sign and date it and then send it in along with your check.

ted the No. 92 M3 after 38 laps to hand over to Dirk Müller. Auberlen pitted eight laps later and Joey Hand took the wheel of the No. 90 M3. Although Müller and Auberlen made late stops for fuel, both drivers were able to regain two class positions over the course of their stints.

Martin Birkmann, BMW of North America Motorsport Manager: "We began the race with high expectations because we tested on this track four weeks ago and achieved second-row qualifying yesterday. After a quarter-mile our hopes were dashed... if it had been a drag race we would've had a better outcome. We need to look carefully at what went wrong, but I am proud of the morale of the team. We fought to recover today and will look to a better result at Lime Rock in July."

Bobby Rahal, Team Principal: "It ruins your day when you have an incident in first corner with both team cars, but I guess they say 'that's racing.' The cars ran reasonably well for the duration of the race and we moved each car forward two positions."

The ALMS will return to competition at Lime Rock Park on July 17-18 for Round 5.

BMW Group Supports Obama's Proposal

Proposal Addresses Future National Fuel, Greenhouse Gas Regulations

May 19, 2009

Munich/Washington, DC.

The BMW Group is in agreement with the direction outlined today by President Obama and his Administration to have the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) work together toward one national standard for regulating future greenhouse gas emissions and fuel economy. "The announcement today by President Obama is a major step in the right direction for automotive manufacturers in the United States such as the BMW Group," said Friedrich Eichiner, Member of the Board of Management of BMW AG. "Consistency of legislation
