



Once again, we're gathering at a historic track; racing began on the roads of Elkhart Lake in 1950, using local roads ala Watkins Glen, and the Road America track opened five years later. Almost unchanged in half a century, the four-mile track is among the longest tracks in North America and nestled in the Kettle Moraine, it is certainly one of the most scenic motorsports venues in the world. (Besides, Road America's track food is considered a gourmet delight; the German-Scandinavian heritage of the region guarantees great brats and beer!)

Our Oktoberfest closing banquet is slated for Friday, August 27, followed by BimmerMeet II on Saturday. In addition, we will have a bonus track day on Sunday, August 29.

The host hotel is the Osthoff Resort in Elkhart Lake, and reservations are now open at 1.800.876.3399. Demand for rooms is high, so we have also added a block of rooms at Siebkens Resort (www.siebkens.com), home of the Stop-Inn Tavern, internationally known as the best bar on the racing circuit. An Oktoberfest Historical Perspective

The comparisons of the modern late summer spectacle of BMW speed to the original concept of Oktoberfest is eerie! How so, you ask? Well, there's much in the historical detail of this celebration that seems to bolt right up to the present. I'll bet you catch this right off. Here's the short version.

Oktoberfest originated as a horse race honoring the marriage of Crown Prince Ludwig, soon to be King Ludwig the 1st, and Princess Therese in 1810. Imagine that, romance and a fete of strength all rolled into one big event. Like I've never seen that before. However, back then, unions of high-society types were more for the acquisition power and wealth than the fuzzy affections of two in love, so perhaps Luddy was trying to distract himself from the responsibilities that were about to swallow his leisure, with cavalier demonstrations of unfettered horsepower. Of course what better way to do that, when you don't have Speed Channel, than a race between guys riding big animals. I couldn't agree more. I was unable to uncover who actually won that contest, I suppose it doesn't really matter anymore, but that horse association lives on still in that even Porsche uses a stallion image in their logo. This race was kicked off in the typical Teutonic fashion with a keg, a hammer and a scream of, "O'zapft is" (translated from the German: It is tapped! A tradition announcing the start of Oktoberfest). Now, I would never suggest that beer and horsepower go together with the same vigor as they did back in 1810. After all, we have more hungry lawyers now, and horses have a built in tendency to self-preservation leading them to think for themselves when their drivers become incapacitated from heavy drinking, and fail to make appropriate corrections at the apex. The part I am most attracted to is this whole 'O'zapft is" thing. I hear that much yelling of, "O'zapft is" as you shoot down the main straight of Road America, or out of 12, ... or 5, encourages a Bimmer's engine much the same as goading an 1810 horse. Some say, that the hovering spirit of King Ludwig responds in positive affirmation to the 'O'zapft is" yell, by conspiring with BMW engine internals to instantly *tap* into 10% more torque at max rpm.

Anyway, German Oktoberfest history begins on either the 12th or the 17th of October, depending on who you consult (Aach, it's only five days different). This lack of controlling legal authority releases us from stiff traditions so that we can celebrate Oktoberfest in August. August is way better weather-wise, plus there are fewer leaves whirling around to plug brake ducts and radiators. Are you catching on to how this all works out? By 1819, the race had largely been forgotten, replaced by beer-carts and a carnival atmosphere. Where's the fun in that! Anybody can gather in streets with carts, get drunk, throw beads and wind up face down in ... whatever. No mad skill sets needed there. Now, horsepower, of either equine or internal combustion, arguably adds much more bravado, risk and purpose to any festival. Raging around a wonderful track like Road America in fine German machinery goes a long way to de-Mardi Gras-a-fication of Ludwig's celebration.

Finally, the politics of Munich decided that Oktoberfest should be held each year, with no exceptions (Who could argue with this. Especially on the 200th anniversary). And Oktoberfest, originally a one-day competitive commemoration, was expanded to 16 days of revelry and heavy drinking. I remain much more content with the concept of shortening 2+ weeks of waste to just one week of fine German machinery, friends, food, learning, and leave the heavy drinking to the New Orleanians.



PAT'S PERSPECTIVE

Joining us on the track? There are still quite a few track days left, so it's a good time to review the fitness of your car. Some club members will be driving in the National O'Fest, but our October 1-2-3 event will draw the most drivers. Along with many routine checks a driver can do, such as checking the oil level and tire pressures, and adjusting the volume on your Premium Bose speakers, there are some bits that can only be seen with the car on the lift. Some are critical to having that happy ending (an intact car) when you're ready to drive home.

I've heard several amusing stories about drivers running their brakes down to the rivets. It's very hard to stop your car with a rivet contact patch of less than a millimeter. The noise those rivets make as they etch ever deeper grooves into your rotors is toxic even to the hard-of-hearing. One member had to drive the eighty plus miles back to Milwaukee from Blackhawk with just this problem. He did fine from the on-ramp to I90 in South Beloit to his exit on Capitol Drive. The last mile to his home was a nail biter.

I wish he had called us. We can check brake pad thickness easily with the car on a lift. If we check the car out a week or more before the event (see last paragraph), we can help you choose replacement pads. Depending on the car and the experience of the driver, we will identify an appropriate pad and can install them, usually in less than an hour. One (not named) instructor always thinks he needs new pads. He usually doesn't. We've saved him some real money for his next aftermarket purchase.

We also check some other important items. With the car on the lift, we can check your wheel bearings, your control arms, your shocks (for leaks), your springs (BMW rear springs on E46 cars are very commonly cracked) and your tires. We can often see the telltale signs of leaking seal, a leaking hose, or even a brake line that's drooping dangerously close to the inside of the wheel.
