## **Track Procedure**

- Checker = cool down ½ lap
- Exit at Turn 5
- Please Do NOT wander around the roads on the facility w/out permission (ask me & I will try to clear it for you)

















# Entering the track... Blend line






















## Exit /end a session = make a fist out the window and exit at Turn 5
















Meeting on the Grid in the Cold Pits

Novice Groups: Release at ~10 second intervals...Intermediate Group: Release non-Lead Follow groups first with a 30 second gap then the LF groups













#### **Instructor Hand Signals**

- Arm up in the air out the window circling = time to swap out on the main straight
- Tap on the roof once = follow more closely
- Tap on the roof two or three times = really follow more closely, catch up, don't dawdle
- Arm out and up with a fist = we are all going in to the pits together (or we are all getting off at 5 at the end of a session)















#### **Swap Procedures**

### Swap Occurs always and only on the front straight

#### Swap Process:

- Lead car gives swap signal to following car
- Following car checks mirrors and turns on right blinker
- When clear, following car moves smoothly to the right to begin the pass
- Car being passed stays on-line and lifts throttle
- Overtaking car completes pass, checks mirrors, returns to racing line (to the left) completing the swap and assuming the lead position

















The Main Straight Sequence

#### Lap I and 2

Instructor leads student both laps No position changes First swap at start of lap 3





Student Cars = Follow

Instructor = Lead






The Main Straight Sequence

#### Lap 3 and 4

Start of lap 3 student passes instructor Student leads through lap 4



Student will smoothly move offline and carefully pass instructor













The Main Straight Sequence

#### Lap 5 and 6

**Start of lap 3 Instructor passes student** Instructor leads through lap 6

















#### **Details of the Lead Follow Instruction & the Process**

#### **Exiting the Track:**

All groups will EXIT at 5 UNLESS there is a problem and the Leader takes his group in to the pits!! At the stop sign onto the Main paddock road everyone will take a slight right and then a left to head to a debrief area set up on the flat area below the Gear Box hill.

We highly recommend a debrief in this Area where there is room to talk and Instructor and student are near each other



There will be signs indicating where the leaders should take their students



## **SAFETY – Passing with a VIRTUAL POINT**

#### Passing:

- All passing in all groups will be done offline by the car doing the overtaking. The car being passed will stay ON LINE
- All passing will be completed before the brake markers













# SAFETY - Passing w/ a VIRTUAL POINT

- Car being Passed
  - A. Stay ON LINE
  - **B. LIFT to allow Pass**
  - C. Multiple passes: One point per pass
  - No Passing without a clear point













# SAFETY - Passing - Specific Examples

14-1 = Complete your turn & Track out to left side of track, point a pass and stay on line, lift, and let cars pass offline on your right.

1-3 = Complete your turn & track out to the left side of the track, point a pass, stay online and let cars pass offline on your right

3-5 = Track out to the left side of the track. After completing the turn, move to right side of track, point a pass, lift and allow pass to complete before brake markers













# **SAFETY – Passing - Examples**

5-6 = Track out to right side of track, point a pass and allow cars to pass offline on the Left.

7-8 = Track out and complete turn - THEN move to the right and point a pass and allow cars to pass offline on the Left.

Exit of Kink to Canada (Turn 12) = Track out of the Kink & point a pass, stay left, and allow cars to pass off line on the right with extreme caution.
