

## Badger Bimmers – Rules for Convertibles at DE Events

Our HPDE events are run using BMW CCA rules for open top cars.

**Please contact Bryce Zuleger (DEC@badgerbimmers.org) BEFORE registering to verify that your open top car will meet our technical requirements.**

Cars with factory folding hard tops are considered standard cars (not open top) for our events and may participate as such. These are cars that have articulating metal roof panels that are not removable from the vehicle. Such tops must remain in the “up” configuration while on the track.

Cars with rigid "Targa" style removable roof panels (i.e., many Corvettes, Porsches, etc.) will be required to have their removable roof panels installed. Canvas or non-rigid roof panels are not allowed.

Cars with soft or fabric tops (including those with permanently attached hard tops) must have a minimum of a 4-point roll bar that meets the material and installation requirements set forth by BMW CCA. This requirement can be certified either by presenting a log book from a recognized sanctioning body (SCCA, NASA, BMW CCA, PCA, etc.) or an inspection document signed by a race car fabrication shop. Cars with soft or no top are also required to have arm restraints for each occupant of the vehicle.
